

# Biblical Faith

**Matthew 9:29** <sup>29</sup> *Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.*

## WHAT IS FAITH?

- **Webster's Dictionary:** firm belief in something for which there is no proof; complete confidence
- **Unger's Bible Dictionary:** "The conviction of the reality of the truths and facts that God has revealed, based solely upon the testimony of God."
- **Holy Bible:** "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." (Hebrews 11:1) GREEK: "substance" = "a standing under, a support, a title deed"

## HOW DOES FAITH WORK?

**It must be a constant attitude or lifestyle, not just a "life preserver!"**

**Romans 10:17** <sup>17</sup> *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

**It must be unashamedly vocalized.**

**Romans 10:8-10** <sup>8</sup> *But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;* <sup>9</sup> *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.* <sup>10</sup> *For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

**It must be accompanied by action.**

**James 2:17-20** <sup>17</sup> *Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.* <sup>18</sup> *Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.* <sup>19</sup> *Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.* <sup>20</sup> *But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?*

**It must disregard the obstacles.**

**Romans 4:19-21** <sup>19</sup> *And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: <sup>20</sup> He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; <sup>21</sup> And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.*

**It will not operate effectively where there is doubt present.**

**Mark 11:23-24** <sup>23</sup> *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

**Mark 6:4-5** <sup>4</sup> *But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. <sup>5</sup> And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.*

## DEGREES OF FAITH

**Little faith - “Why Are You Fearful?” (Battles Fear and Doubts God Constantly)**

**Disciples in Storm - Matthew 8:26** <sup>26</sup> *And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. (KJV)*

**Peter Walking on Water - Matthew 14:31** <sup>31</sup> *And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? (KJV)*

**Sermon on the Mount - Matthew 6:30** <sup>30</sup> *Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? (KJV)*

**Faith - “Thy Faith Hath Made Thee Whole” (Needs Immediate Sign or Feeling to Confirm)**

**Woman With Issue of Blood - Matthew 9:22** <sup>22</sup> *But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.*

**Blind Bartimaeus - Mark 10:52** <sup>52</sup> *And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.*

**Great Faith - “Go Thy Way” (Believes “Long Distance” - Without Sign or Feeling) - only 2X**

**Centurion with Sick Servant - Matthew 8:10,13** <sup>10</sup> *When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. <sup>13</sup> And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.*

**Woman with Demon-Possessed Daughter - Matthew 15:28** <sup>28</sup> *Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.*
