

## MY NEVER AGAIN LIST

(A BOLD CHALLENGE TO "SPEAK THE WORD ONLY" - MATTHEW 8:8)

FIRST: Inability	Never again will I confess <i>"I can't"</i> , for <i>"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me"</i> (Phil. 4:13).
SECOND: Poverty	Never again will I confess lack, for <i>"My God shall supply all of my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus"</i> (Phil. 4:19).
THIRD: Fear	Never again will I confess fear, for <i>"God hath not given me the spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind"</i> (II Tim. 1:7; see also Prov. 28:1).
FOURTH: Doubt	Never again will I confess doubt and lack of faith for , <i>"God hath given to every man the measure of faith"</i> (Rom. 12:3).
FIFTH: Weakness	Never again will I confess weaknesses, for <i>"the Lord is the strength of my life"</i> (Psa. 27: 1) and <i>"The people that know their God shall be strong and do exploits"</i> (Dan. 11:32; see also Joel 3: 10).
SIXTH: Satan's Rule	Never again will I confess that Satan is dominating my life, for <i>"Greater is He that is in (me) than he that is in the world"</i> (I John 4:4; see also Romans 8:37).
SEVENTH: Defeat	Never again will I confess defeat, for <i>"God always causeth me to triumph in Christ Jesus"</i> (II Cor. 2:14).
EIGHTH: Lack of Wisdom	Never again will I confess lack of wisdom, for <i>"Christ Jesus is made unto me wisdom from God"</i> (I Cor. 1: 30).
NINTH: Sickness	Never again will I confess sickness. for <i>"With His stripes I am healed"</i> (Isa. 53:5) and Jesus <i>"Himself took my infirmities and bore my sicknesses"</i> (Matt. 8:17 and Exod.15:26).
TENTH: Anxiety	Never again will I confess worries or frustrations for I am <i>"casting all my cares upon Him, for He careth for me"</i> (I Pet. 5:7).
ELEVENTH: Bondage	Never again will I confess bondage, for <i>"Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty"</i> (II Cor. 3:17).
TWELFTH: Guilt	Never again will I confess condemnation, for <i>"There is no now therefore no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus"</i> (Rom. 8: 1).
