(Ecc 4:9) Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labor.

(Ecc 4:10) For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. (Ecc 4:11) Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone?

(Ecc 4:12) And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

 We need one another if we will prevail as a church. Whether we like to admit it or not, we all need some support some time.

(Heb 10:25) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

- What is the point in assembling together?

(Rom 12:4) For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:

(Rom 12:5) So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.
