## **Scripture:**

1 Peter 1:19-25

But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

- 20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,
- 21 Who by him do believe in God that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.
- 22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- 23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- 24 For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:
- 25 But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. Amen
- Eph 5:27... That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
- 1 Corinthians 9 says, he is not coming back after;
- 1. the unrighteous because they shall not inherit the kingdom of God?
- 2. Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters,
- 3. nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,
- 4. nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards,
- 5. nor revilers, nor extortioners.

None of these shall inherit the kingdom of God.

He is only coming back after these:

Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come **and his wife hath** made herself ready

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
