Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

- I. Tug of War
 - A. School
 - B. Back and forth struggle
 - 1. Pulling and tugging
 - 2. Exertion of strength
 - 3. Gritting your teeth & digging in your heels
 - a) Eventually one would win and one would lose
- II. What is described here?
 - A. There is a battle
 - 1. Two contestants
 - a) Michael the Archangel God's highest angel
 - b) Satan the chiefest of the fallen angels
 - 2. A battle between good and evil
 - a) What is this battle waged over?
 - b) A battle that is waged over mankind
 - B. Michael
 - 1. As the Archangel, probably took the position vacated by Satan
 - 2. Daniel -

- 3. Descend with Jesus at the day of the Rapture
- 4. Will ultimately cast down Satan Rev.12:7
 - a) Has a past filled with victory over Satan
 - b) Has a future filled with victory over Satan

C. Satan

- 1. Used to be the Archangel
 - a) Tried to exalt himself to God's level
 - b) Was cast down out of Heaven
 - c) Was the cause of Man's fall from grace
 - d) Will eventually be destroyed by God

D. The Battle

- 1. How do they fight?
 - a) They contend, they struggle, back and forth like a tug of war
 - (1) But Michael does not bring an accusation.
 - (2) This means that he does not rely on his own strength to beat Satan
 - (3) He calls on the Lord to rebuke Satan
 - (a) Satan was never humble and that's what got him tossed out of Heaven

E. The Body of Moses

- 1. Literal body Moses burial site is unknown
 - a) God took him up Mount Nebo to die. God had other plans for Moses body
 - (1) He appears with Jesus on the mount of transfiguration

- (2) He appears in the book of Revelation as one of the two witnesses
- (3) The Devil was trying to disrupt God's plan
- (4) Perhaps he was trying to set Moses up as an idol
- 2. Figurative Body the Jewish Nation
 - a) God's chosen people
 - b) The Devil was always trying to pervert that nation
 - c) They would do good, then fall out with God, then repent and be restored,
- 3. Figurative Body the Church
 - a) We are God's chosen people
 - b) The devil is constantly trying to disrupt the body of Christ
 - c) He would love to sow discord among us, or cause us to stop reaching our world
- 4. Figurative Body Mankind
 - a) The Devil's ultimate goal is to enslave as much of mankind as he can in a web of sin
 - b) He wants to destroy as many souls as he can in Hell.

III. Today

A. The Battle

1. Even though we can't see it, there are spiritual struggles taking place.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- a) There are spiritual forces at work in our city, state, country, and world.
- b) Daniel Guy that threw himself into the water Herd of Swine -
- c) We cannot overcome them by our own power. We must call on the name of the Lord.
- (1) We must rebuke them in Jesus name 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
 - (2) Prayer and fasting
 - B. Individuals
 - 1. The devil wants to destroy God's plan for your life
 - a) God has a ministry for you
 - 2. The devil wants to stop your victory
 - 3. The devil wants to steal you away and destroy your soul in hell
- 4. You cannot stand up to him on your own Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- 5. You must humble yourself and call on the name of Jesus Acts 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord
 - a) That's why Satan was cast out and can never win
 - b) He was unwilling to humble himself and call out to God
 - c) Are you willing to humble yourself today?

d) Do you want to win your spiritual struggle? Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.
