- Absolutely not, but it makes me wonder is anybody trusting the Lord right now?
- Is there a virus? Yes
- Is it deadly? Yes
- Are we going to be affected by it? Yes
- Will we or someone we know die from it? It's very possible.
- Does that mean that God is still not on the throne? Absolutely not.

But, let's put some things into prospective.

- There have been over a half a million seasonal flu hospitalizations this flu season according to the CDC.
- There have been somewhere between 30,000 and 55,000 deaths, not from Coronavirus, but from the seasonal flu.

- Over 40,000 people die in automobile accidents each year.

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It's crazy

- People are worried about the worry.
- They are cleaning out the supermarkets because they are worried that other people's worry will cause our supermarkets to not have enough food and supplies to go around. So they are "stocking up".
- They are not stocking up...
- They are hording.

Instead of common sense, they are taking things in excess that other people will have to go without.

• That's greed!

My friend who has a special needs grandson told me that he is driving around trying to distilled or filtered water and formula that his special needs grandson absolutely has to have to survive and he can't find it because people are raiding the shelves of water and hording it.

Now I remember drinking from the hose as a kid.

- I remember the smell of the well water we drank from.
- We are not going to run out of water guys...
- Does anyone remember when they didn't bottle it up and charge us a buck a gallon for it?
- I do.
- I thought it was the dumbest thing in the world when someone said they were going to charge as much for a bottle of water as they were for a bottle of pop.

And here Fred is driving all over Houston Texas trying to find filtered water for his special needs grandson because panic has caused hording.

• And non-Christians are not the only one's hording.

Do you know what hording tells me?

- People don't trust the Lord for their provision.
- They don't trust that God is able to provide for them.

Romans 8:15

For ye have not received the spirit of <u>bondage again to fear</u>; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Fear brings with it Bondage.

• But adoption brings an understanding of who our Heavenly Father is.

Adoption brings protection

- Adoption brings provision
- Adoption brings care

'Jesus I'm not afraid of the Coronavirus, because I know when I cry out to you, you are going to hear my prayers."

"If I get sick with it, I know you'll heal me of it."

Daniel Chapter 3 – an amazing story.

Read it for yourselves.

But, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; end up being not only threatened by but ultimately thrown into a firey furnace because they would not bow down to a false God that Nebuchadnezzar made.

- So the king gets mad, heats the furnace 7 times hotter and throws,
 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; into the fire.
- Certain death.
- The fire was so hot that it instantly burned to death the men who threw, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; into the fire.

But what about, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego;

Daniel 3:23 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

24 Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men <u>loose</u>, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

We threw 3 into the fire... but who is that 4th guy?

• "It looks like the Son Of God."

Listen folks, Jesus didn't just show up as the Baby in the manger in Bethlehem.

• He showed up on the day that Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego needed a savior.

• And He'll show up in your life today too if you will let him.

Hebrews 13:8 King James Version (KJV) 8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

He was Jesus in the firey furnace,

- He was Jesus the day you needed a savior,
- and He is the Jesus you need in your life right now for help, protection, strength, blessing,
- and the faith to have courage when the rest of the world is in calamity.

Why don't we lift our hands and our hearts and just magnify Him because He is God right now!

Come on, let's glorify the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords together.
